

Ideas for 2020 FFAST State Legislative Priorities

1. Establish the Florida Assistive Technology Trust Fund
 - a. Source of Funds
 - i. A percentage of penalties from texting while driving citations.
 - ii. 10 to 12% of the non-refundable application fee from Medical Marijuana Treatment Centers.
 1. The application fee is \$60,063.
 2. For FY 2016, the Florida Department of Health received 28 applications.
 3. FY 2016 total application fees produced \$1,681,764.
 4. 10% of this amount is \$168,176.
 5. 12% of this amount is \$201,811.
 - iii. A small percentage (0.0065) of applications and renewal fees from Registry Identification Cards.
2. FFAST advocates for the creation of a task force to investigate and recommend improvements to Florida's Disabled Parking Permit program.
